

Editor's Letter

The Bulletin of the Polytechnic Institute of Iasi is a publication with long tradition in academics, founded in 1946 by Professor Dimitrie I. Mangeron from Iasi. Over the years, his scientific approach has been joined by Professors Hugo Rosman and Alfred Braier. Three Nobel laureates published here: Louis de Broglie, Nobel Prize laureate of Physics in 1929, published four articles on the pages of the magazine in 1963, 1964, 1967 and 1968; Italian chemist Giulio Natta, Nobel Laureate of Chemistry in 1963, published two articles in 1967, and American physicist John Hasbrouck van Vleck, Nobel Prize laureate of Physics in 1977, published an article in 1970.

The increase in the areas of interest approached in the articles publication led to the split of specialized sections of the Bulletin, so we find in 1971 the Mathematics. Theoretical Mechanics. Physics section as distinct part of the Bulletin of the Polytechnic Institute of Iasi. In this section, both "classical" subjects in the field of mathematics, theoretical mechanics and physics, as well as current subjects from biomathematics, biomechanics, biophysics, life sciences, etc., with strong social and economic impact, were approached.

Nowadays, the Bulletin of the Polytechnic Institute of Iasi, the section Mathematics. Theoretical Mechanics. Physics benefits from the academic support of an outstanding Editorial Board composed of researchers from various fields of scientific interest from both the direct fields of the journal as well as related domains (medicine, social sciences, electronics, etc.). Through the quality and scientific coverage of the published articles, this academic approach has an important place in the publications.

The aim of the journal is to publish the results of fundamental, applied or theoretical research of both Romanian and foreign authors, being edited in English. It is an academic platform interconnecting universities, research institutes and any other scientific, educational institution. It has a frequency of 4 annual numbers (quarterly). The following types of materials are accepted for publication:

- original research work
- review articles
- book reviews
- technical notes
- addresses to the publisher
- case studies
- preliminary communications
